

## Postdoc Positions in High-Energy Hadron Physics at KEK

The KEK Theory Center is seeking candidates for a postdoctoral position beginning in September 2010. This position is funded by a Japanese research grant (Representative: Dr. Kazunori Itakura, KEK). The contract is for a single year (starting from April), with possible extensions for an outstanding postdoc, until March 2014 at the longest.

Expected salary is about 250,000 JPY per month depending on the research career. The grant is dedicated to the 4-year project of constructing a new simulation code for the extensive air showers induced by cosmic rays based on a modern picture of QCD, and the postdoc will work on making hadronic interaction models and/or coding.
